STATIONS OF THE CROSS

The theme for the artworks is Lent/Easter. The entries are based around the Stations of the Cross.

The Stations of the Cross depict the final hours (or the Passion) of Jesus. They are usually a series of images showing the following 14 scenes.

1. Jesus is condemned to death
2. Jesus is given his cross
3. Jesus falls the first time
4. Jesus meets his mother
5. Simon of Cyrene carries the cross
6. Veronica wipes the face of Jesus
7. Jesus falls the second time

8. Jesus meets the daughters of Jerusalem
9. Jesus falls the third time
10. Jesus is stripped of his garments
11. Crucifixion: Jesus is nailed to the cross
12. Jesus dies on the cross
13. Jesus' body is removed from the cross (Deposition or Lamentation)
14. Jesus is laid in the tomb and covered in incense.

Minimum size for artwork is A3
